Take A closer Look at Cancer Details Cancer Situation in Gaza Strip

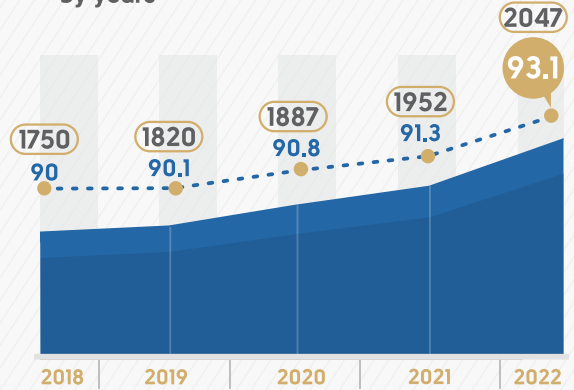

Overview

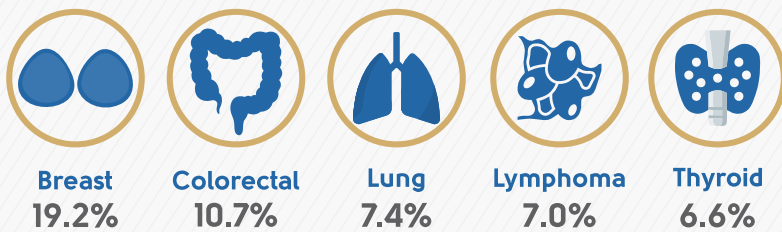
Cancer is a major public health problem and it is the second leading cause of death worldwide. In this infographic, we provide the statistics of new cancer cases and deaths during the last five years in the Gaza Strip, as well as a comprehensive overview of cancer occurrence based on the latest population-based data.

During the last five years in Gaza Strip, **9,456** new cancer cases were reported and **3,785** patients have died of cancer. Out of the new reported cases, **5,201** were female, **4,255** were male.

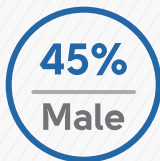
Incidence rate of all cancers / 100,000 pop. by years



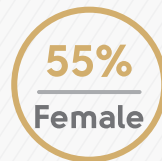
Percentage of most common cancers among population



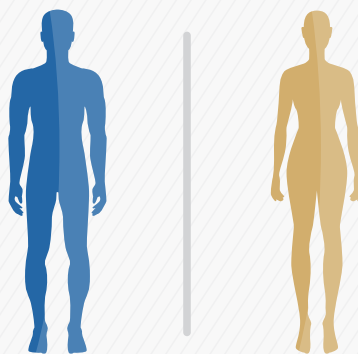
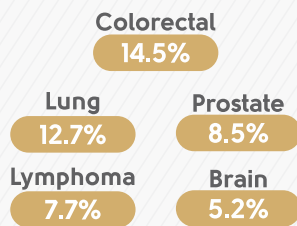

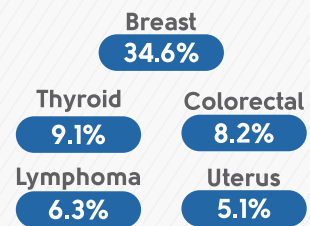
Proportional distribution of cancer by gender



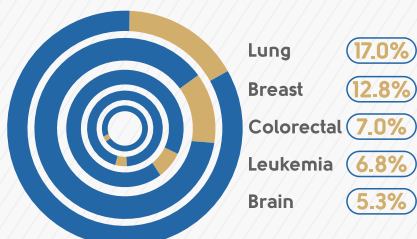
Percentage of the most common male cancers



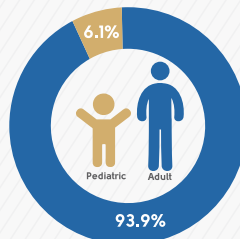
Percentage of the most common Female cancers
